WAY, FOLKESTONE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Shorncliffe Road and Risborough Way, Folkestone.

Overnight closures are currently planned from Monday 8 March 2021 for up to 2 nights, from 20:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

Shorncliffe Road and Risborough Way will be closed between the junction with B2063 Risborough Lane and the western junction with Shorncliffe Crescent, to the actual extent shown at any time.

The alternative route for through traffic is via B2063 Risborough Lane, Military Road, A259 Sandgate High Street, Sandgate Hill, Sandgate Road and B2064 Shorncliffe Road.

Enbrook Valley will be closed at the junction with Shorncliffe Road as the works progress, with access continuing from a southern direction via B2063 Military Road and Enbrook Road.

Shorncliffe Crescent will be closed at its western junction with Shorncliffe Road, with access continuing from its eastern junction.

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for residents (including Ferne Way and Laurel Close) when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.
